

STATEMENT OF INTENT

As Chief Operating Officer of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), Department of Health and Human Services, I exercise expressed authority and responsibility to request FDA funds for decommissioning activities associated with the operations authorized by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Material License No. 20-08361-01. This authority is established by FDA Staff Manual Guide 1410.21 *General Redelegations of Authority from the Commissioner to Other Officers of the Food and Drug Administration*. The FDA has estimated the cost of decommissioning its facilities under the aforementioned license to be \$1,238,783. Within my authority noted above, I intend to request that funds be made available, when necessary, in the estimated amount of \$1,548,479 (inclusive of requisite 25% contingency) to decommission facilities authorized under the

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I intend to request and obtain these funds sufficiently in advance of the decommissioning to prevent delay of required activities.
