Dear Mr. Fuller:

On May 25, 2016, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) cited QSA Global, Inc. for failure to submit an import notification that contained the correct activity level in terabecquerels, the correct shipment date, and estimated arrival date associated with its January 25, 2016 shipment, as required by Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 110.7a (a), "Completeness and Accuracy of Information." The Notice of Violation, required you to respond in writing within 30 days (NRC Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML16055A141). You responded by letter dated June 7, 2016 (ML16176A095).

After reviewing the information you provided in your response to the Notice of Violation, we have concluded that your completed and proposed actions appear to adequately address the regulatory noncompliance described in the Notice of Violation.
