By letter dated December 18, 2015 (Agencywide Document Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML15364A561), Holtec International (Holtec) submitted an amendment request to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for the HI-STORM Flood/Wind Multipurpose Canister (MPC) Storage System Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 1032.

In a letter dated April 22, 2016 (ADAMS Accession No. ML16113A398), Holtec modified the amendment request to remove proposed changes #2 and #3 which are related to the hydrostatic and helium leak tests. Please provide an updated safety analysis report (SAR) and CoC accordingly.
