Dear Mr. Viellenave:

By letter dated October 3, 2012, AUC LLC (AUC) submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) an application for a source and byproduct materials license for the proposed Reno Creek In Situ Recovery (ISR) Project located in Campbell County, Wyoming. In order to approve a license application, the NRC staff reviews the application for technical compliance with the Atomic Energy Act, as amended; NRC regulations; and for related environmental effects in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act.

The NRC staff's technical review will be documented in a Safety Evaluation Report (SER). In the process of completing the SER for the Reno Creek Project, the NRC staff provided a draft license to AUC for review and comment on July 8, 2015 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] ML15154B494). On August 18, 2015, AUC submitted comments on the draft license (ML15230A566). On October 8, 2015, the NRC staff conducted a public meeting to discuss AUC's comments and the results of this discussion were documented in a meeting summary dated November 23, 2015 (ML15323A358). In these discussions, the staff noted that the draft license had not been subjected to legal review and was subject to change.

The NRC recently completed a legal review of the draft license which resulted in some changes. Therefore, the staff requests that AUC review the enclosed revised draft license and respond within 30 days of the date of this letter indicating if AUC agrees with the revised draft license or by providing written comments if AUC disagrees with specific conditions in the draft license.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's ADAMS. ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.
