Please find the attached language which is how the State prefers to incorporate the SECY language. Additionally we added language to exclude independent commercial laboratories. I think this should solve the issue of 11e.(2) material at laboratories for testing. We will be sending this to the Joint Minerals Committee for vote end of this month. If any of the language is insufficient or NRC would prefer us to change it would be ideal to have it by the end of the month. If we hear no response by then we will move forward with the proposed language.
