7.1 Senior Management

The Radiation Safety Office staff is under the Director for Environmental Health and Occupational Safety (EHS). EHS has direct access to the University President, USU through the Vice President, Finance and Administration. Management review of the Radiation Safety Program is integrated into the membership of the Radiation Safety Committee. The Chief of Staff to the University President (PRS) and the Director, EHS are both permanent voting members of the committee.

Charles L. Rice, MD, resigned as the University President effective 22 July 2016. Richard W. Thomas, MD, DDS, is the new University President effective 25 July 2016. There has been no further change to the senior leadership.
