

## INSTRUCTIONS

The export of byproduct material or of source material is prohibited unless the exporter holds a specific AEC license to export or unless export is made under general license described in the regulation 10 CFR Parts 30 or 40. APPLICATION FOR SPECIFIC AEC EXPORT LICENSE SHALL BE MADE ON THIS FORM AEC-7 IN TRIPLICATE. In the event authorization is granted, the AEC will issue to the applicant a specific Export License. At the time shipment is made, the Export License must be presented to the Collector of Customs at the port of exit from the United States, or to the Postmaster at the Post Office of mailing, for endorsement and return to the AEC. The license to export extends to the licensee's duly authorized shipping agent. In the event the application is denied, the AEC will so notify the applicant by letter.

"Shipper's Export Declaration(s)" (Department of Commerce Form 7525-V) are also to be prepared, in accordance with the instructions on that form, and submitted to the Collector of Customs or the Postmaster at the same time the Export License is presented.

Item 8(a)—State the amount of byproduct material in millicuries or curies (state which unit is used). State the weight of contained thorium and uranium in pounds or kilograms (state which unit is used) and the net weight of the shipment (for example, 10 pounds thorium contained in 250 pounds thorium magnesium alloy).
