Dear Ms. Henderson:

The final regulations were effective 08/25/16 and published in the 09/09/16 state register at [http://www.cyberdriveillinois.com/departments/index/register/register\\_volume40\\_issue37.pdf](http://www.cyberdriveillinois.com/departments/index/register/register_volume40_issue37.pdf) on pages 12949 - 13015. These changes correspond to equivalent provisions in the NRC regulations as noted in RATS ID # 2013-2.

We incorporated the comments from your 05/24/16 review of our proposed rules as follows:

**“Illinois’ rule has an incorrect reference, i.e., the reference “330.325(b)(1)(ii)” should read “330.325(b)(1)(B)(ii)”. Illinois needs to correct the reference to read 330.325(b)(1)(B)(ii), to meet the Compatibility Category C designation assigned to 10 CFR 40.22.”**

This comment was incorporated in 330.210(c) at the top of page 12984.

No other substantive changes occurred. We believe that adoption of these revisions satisfies the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-200.
