The State of South Carolina, through FEMA Region IV, has requested postponement of the Oconee Nuclear Station radiological emergency preparedness (REP) exercise presently scheduled for October 18, 2016. We understand that dealing with the impact of Hurricane Matthew will require South Carolina and the risk jurisdictions to focus on response and recovery activities beyond the currently scheduled exercise date.
