SUMMARY

The call commenced at 2 P.M. with the NRC explaining that the purpose of the call was to request revised calculations referenced in an additional information request response submitted on September 27, 2016 (ML16272A388). Specifically, Dominion had referenced a revised thermal calculation for normal conditions of storage, but had not provided the revised calculation. Dominion explained that the revised calculation demonstrated the predicted neutron shield temperature remained below the maximum allowable temperature for the neutron shield using more realistic thermal parameters; therefore, they felt the sensitivity analysis provided in their September 27, 2016 response would allow the NRC to complete their review. The NRC responded that not only did the use of different thermal parameters constitute a new licensing basis for the amendment, but also using details from multiple documents made it difficult to clearly articulate coherent regulatory and safety findings. When Dominion inquired which additional documents should be submitted, the NRC responded that, in addition to a revised Design Licensing Basis Document, any calculation which utilized the new parameters should be submitted. Dominion stated that they would discuss this with AREVA and provide the NRC
