This is a retraction of the note below. There was no missing sample. Here is the explanation.

After reviewing the analytical report from Energy Labs for UCL analysis, I discovered an error on the CoC submitted to Energy Labs that caused some confusion. It was thought that the sample MO-108 10/13/2016 was missing upon submittal to the Lab. However, MO-108 10/13/2016 was actually analyzed by Energy Labs which was thought to be MO-108 10/6/2016. This is because both were listed on the CoC whereby MO-108 10/6/2016 should have been omitted. The MO-108 10/6/2016 was actually pulled from the set and analyzed by the Lost Creek Lab on 10/7/2016 before the set (that included the MO-108 10/13/2016) was sent to Energy Labs on 10/13/2016.
