**SUBJECT: TERMINATION OF YOUR NRC RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE**

Dear Mr. Von Hoven:

In letter dated September 8, 2016, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed the documentation that you have provided. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility located at 8900 Keystone Crossing, Suite 900, Indianapolis, Indiana, is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 13-32699-01 is hereby terminated.
