Re: **Emergence from Bankruptcy Notification – Wolf Run Mining Company's Sentinel Complex, License GL-640928-20**

To Whom It May Concern:

Per our previous notice to NRC dated January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2016, Arch Coal Inc. and certain of its direct and indirect subsidiaries (collectively the "Company") filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the U. S. Bankruptcy Code. This notice is to inform NRC that on October 5, 2016, the Company consummated its plan of reorganization (the "Plan") and emerged from Chapter 11. Pursuant to the Plan, the Company's emergence from Chapter 11 did not constitute a change in control.

During the Chapter 11 reorganizing process, and upon emergence, Wolf Run Mining Company has retained control of all sources assigned to the Sentinel Complex under General License Number: **GL-640928-20**. The Radiation Safety Officer remains Tom Freeman at this time.

No operational changes have affected the use or location of source materials covered under NRC license control. All materials licensed under **GL-640928-20** are secure and will continue to be utilized and operated as normal going forward.
