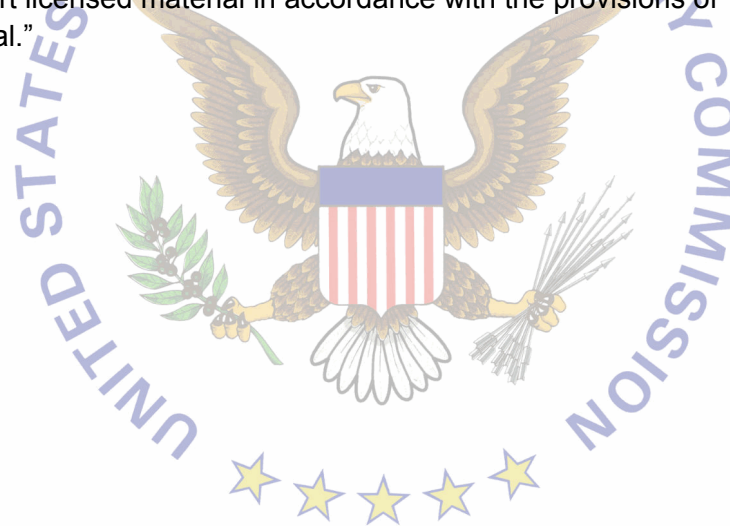

Parenteral administration of any beta emitter, or a photon-emitting radionuclide with a photon energy less than 150keV, for which a written directive is required.
