Dear Dr. Adem:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 10 renewing your NRC Material License No. 24-32613-01 in accordance with your request. Your license has been renewed for a term of ten years and will not expire until October 31, 2026.

At this time, we also deleted Condition No. 13, as it appeared on Amendment No. 09, in favor of adding reference to 10 CFR Part 71 in the Preamble language at the top of page 1 of your license. We also adjusted the documents listed in Condition No. 13, which has been reordered as a result of the deletion of your former Condition No. 13.

Please note that your application dated April 26, 2016, was incomplete in several respects. As a result, we retained reference to your application dated March 7, 2006, limited only to the commitments that were incomplete or missing from your current renewal application. Please be mindful of what is necessary to complete your licensing correspondence correctly in the future, as required by 10 CFR 30.9.

Please also be reminded of the provisions in 10 CFR 30.9(a), "Completeness and accuracy of information,"..."(a) Information provided to the Commission by an applicant for a license or by a licensee or information required by statute or by the Commission's regulations, orders, or license conditions to be maintained by the applicant or the licensee *shall be complete and accurate in all material respects.*"

We also noted that your facility diagram for the Farmington, Missouri location was very minimally adequate. In the future, please prepare and submit a more complete, accurate and appropriately detailed diagram for this facility, in accordance with NUREG 1556 Vol. 9, Rev. 2, section 8.16, item 9, on our website at:

We also noted what appear to be discrepancies between your mailing address in Festus, Missouri and your location of use in Crystal City, Missouri. We prepared your license in accordance with the direction stated on your application dated April 26, 2016. Please review your application and your renewed license carefully and if there are, in fact, discrepancies, please contact me to discuss these matters and how to resolve them.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you.

This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.

Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011. While a policy statement and not a regulation, it sets forth the agency's *expectations* for individuals and organizations to establish and maintain a positive safety culture.
