Pat,

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received your Certification of Non-Possession which documents that Global Laser Enrichment (GLE) has removed all classified material out of the Laser Test Lab, (Agencywide Documents Access and Management Systems (ADAMS) Accession Number ML16287A427). This change was previously submitted by GLE as part of revision 14 to the Standard Practices and Procedures Plan dated July 29, 2016, (ADAMS No. ML16263A037) and approved by the NRC via letter dated October 3, 2016, (ADAMS No. ML16250A304).

The NRC staff from the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response and Region II walked down the GLE Laser Test Lab on October 18, 2016, to ensure that all classified material had been removed. The lab appeared to meet the GLE procedures for no longer storing classified material. Therefore, on the basis of NRC's review and GLE's procedures for removing all classified material from the lab, the GLE Laser Test Lab is approved for uncleared individuals to perform work.

Regarding the signature page for the GLEP-00053-R, Revision 2, Program Cyber Security Plan Annual Continuous Monitoring Report, please go ahead and resend it with the updated signatures. The current version we have is a signed draft, which is not sufficient for us to conclude our review.
