Re: Nuclear Materials License No. 21-12829-01 – Metropolitan Hospital d/b/a Metro Health Hospital – Notice of Proposed Affiliation of Metropolitan Health Corporation with UM Health and Regents of the University of Michigan

Dear Materials Licensing Branch Chief:

This letter is notice to you that Metropolitan Health Corporation ("MHC") proposes to affiliate with the Regents of the University of Michigan through its subsidiary UM Health (the "Affiliation"). As part of the proposed Affiliation, MHC, which is the sole corporate member of the licensee Metropolitan Hospital d/b/a Metro Health Hospital ("Metro Health Hospital"), will amend and restate its articles of incorporation to convert from a directorship corporation to a nonstock, membership corporation, of which UM Health, a newly created nonprofit membership corporation, will be the sole corporate member. UM Health is itself a membership corporation, whose sole corporate membership is held by the Regents of the University of Michigan, a Michigan constitutional corporation. The Affiliation is expected to take effect on or about November 30, 2016.

Pursuant to NUREG -1556, below is the required information:

1. The Affiliation will result in a change of control of MHC. There will be no change in the corporate identification number of MHC or any of its subsidiaries that own or operate health care facilities. There will also be no change in any health care facility owned or operated by MHC or its subsidiaries.
2. The Affiliation will not result in any changes in personnel responsible for the Radiation Safety Program, authorized users, or any other persons identified on the license or in the license application as having responsibility for radiation safety or authorized to use licensed material. Jeffrey J. McClure, M.D. will remain the Radiation Safety Officer.
3. Except for the change in control resulting from the Affiliation, there will be no changes in the organization, location, facilities, equipment or procedures that relate to the licensed program. In addition, there will be no changes in the use, possession, location, or storage of licensed materials as a result of the Affiliation.


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4. All required surveillance has been performed, documented, and reviewed. In September 2016, Medical Physics Consultants, Inc. performed its inspections of Metro Health Hospital's Nuclear Medicine Department, Greenville Heart and Vascular Nuclear Medicine Department, and Health and Vascular Nuclear Medicine Department. At present time, all values meet the physicist standards as well as NRC guidelines. We expect the status to remain compliant at the time of the Affiliation. The most recent Radiation Safety Committee meeting was September 2016. The next meeting will be in December 2016.
5. All records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will remain in place.
6. The licensed program will continue to comply with any existing constraints, conditions, requirements and commitments.

We would appreciate receiving your consent to the change of control of MHC as soon as possible. Thank you for your assistance with this matter.
