Attached are copies of a document entitled "Answer To The NRC Staff Questions on The Westinghouse Evaluation of The Effect of Grid Deformation on ECCS Performance." This information is being submitted in support of the application associated with the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant.

This submittal contains information proprietary to Westinghouse Electric Corporation, and it is supported by a previously submitted affidavit signed by Westinghouse, the owner of the information. The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the information may be withheld from public disclosure by the Commission and addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b) (4) of Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.

Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that the information which is proprietary to Westinghouse be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations. 
Dear Mr. Stolz:

The proprietary material for which withholding is being requested by Pacific Gas and Electric Company is of the same technical type as that proprietary material previously submitted by Westinghouse concerning the evaluation of the reactor coolant system for postulated loss-of-coolant accidents for the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. The previous application for withholding, AW-78-1, was accompanied by a non-proprietary affidavit signed by the owner of the proprietary information, Westinghouse Electric Corporation, which is equally applicable to the subject material. The subject proprietary material is being submitted in support of the application associated with Pacific's Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant.

Accordingly, this letter authorizes the utilization of the previously furnished affidavit, AW-78-1 dated January 20, 1978, in support of the application associated with Pacific's Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant, a copy of which is attached.
