Enclosed is Amendment No. 02 terminating your NRC Materials License No. 13-32758-01 in accordance with your request.

In letter dated August 22, 2016, you contacted the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate NRC Materials License No. 13-32758-01 for Beam, Longest & Neff, LLC. The aforementioned correspondence included information, supporting the decommissioning of your location of use at 8126 Castleton Road, Indianapolis, Indiana.


The NRC staff has reviewed all of this information, including your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility at 8126 Castleton Road, Indianapolis, Indiana is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC License No. 13-32758-01 is hereby terminated.
