Enclosed is Amendment No. 10 terminating your NRC Materials License No. 24-32406-01 in accordance with your request.

In correspondence dated August 22, 2016, you contacted the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate NRC Materials License No. 24-32406-01 for Hutchens Construction Company. The aforementioned correspondence included NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," dated August 22, 2016, with attachments, supporting the decommissioning of your locations of use at 20753 Farm Road 1240, Shell Knob, Missouri and 11241 Farm Road 2060, Monet, Missouri.


The NRC staff has reviewed all of this information, including your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your respective facilities at 20753 Farm Road 1240, Shell Knob, Missouri and 11241 Farm Road 2060, Monet, Missouri, are suitable for unrestricted use and NRC License No. 24-32406-01 is hereby terminated.
