Enclosed are two applications dated October 21, 2016, and October 27, 2016, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), from EnergySolutions Services, Inc., requesting Amendment No. 01 to its existing licenses XW018 and IW029. The import license (IW029) presently authorizes the import of radioactive waste from Germany to incinerate contaminated material in order to reduce the volume. The export license (XW018) presently authorizes the export of radioactive waste to Germany (XW018) to return the incinerated ash, as well as non-incinerable or non-conforming material identified during inspection prior to incineration, for disposition in Germany.


This license is amended to: 1) change the company name from Duratek to EnergySolutions Services, Inc., and 2) extend the date of expiration from December 31, 2016 to December 31, 2021.
