As soon as possible, please apply for an amendment to ask for a change in RSO. It could take up to 90-days for approval for the amendment from the time we receive your amendment request. There is no cost associated with a license amendment.

You will need to designate a qualified person to act as the RSO in the interim.

Please don't forget license condition number 11, that licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, one of the authorized users on the current license; i.e., Evan Kimberly or Joseph Tabeling. If you will continue to be an authorized user and/ or if you will be adding other authorized users on the license then please state so in the application.

To apply for an amendment, please fill out an NRC Form 313 (attached) and have it signed/ dated by a certifying officer, which in this case could be Mr. Tabeling since he is the President of the company. Please send it to:
