The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is requesting a time extension for comments on the subject document until December 23, 2016. As of the date of this letter, the EPA Regional Office has still not received its required hardcopies of the FEIS per EPA's filing procedures.

Due to the voluminous size of the FEIS (i.e., > than 1,200 pages) and the organization of the response to comments, the EPA is requesting additional time to provide a succinct and concise review.
