SUPPORT DOCUMENTS" SUBMITTED DECEMBER 3, 2016
(CAC NO. MF8411)

Dear Mr. Andrashov:

By letter dated December 3, 2016 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession (ADAMS) No. ML16344A246), Research and Production Corporation Radiy (RPC Radiy) submitted a December 3, 2016, affidavit executed by Mark J. Burrzynski, U.S. Licensing Manager. The affidavit requested that the information contained in the documents listed in the enclosure be withheld from public disclosure under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 2.390, "Hearing Requests, Petitions to Intervene, Requirements for Standing, and Conditions."

The letter stated that RPC Radiy did not plan to submit a nonproprietary versions of the documents. The basis given was that, because of the extensive amount of proprietary information in the documents, nonproprietary versions would be of no value to the public.

The RPC Radiy affidavit detailed the reasons for withholding the information.

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has reviewed the RPC Radiy application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390. On the basis of the statements in the affidavit, the NRC staff has determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure. Therefore, the versions of the submitted information marked as proprietary will be withheld from public disclosure under 10 CFR 2.390(b)(5) and Section 103(b) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended.

Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents. If the need arises, the NRC staff may send copies of this information to its consultants working in this area. The agency will of course, ensure that the NRC staff consultants have signed the appropriate agreements for handling proprietary information.

If the basis for withholding this information from public inspection should change in the future such that the information could then be made available for public inspection, you should promptly notify the NRC.

You also should understand that the NRC staff may have cause to review this determination in the future, for example, if the scope of a Freedom of Information Act request includes your information. In all review situations, if the NRC staff makes a determination adverse to the above, you will be notified in advance of any public disclosure.
