RNP received two NRC-identified Non Cited Violations (Green NCVs) of very low safety significance, five licensee-identified Non Cited Violations (Green NCVs) of very low safety significance, and an Unresolved Item (URI) from the NRC Inspection of Implementation of Interim Cyber Security Milestones 1-7, contained in Inspection Report 05000261/2015405.

The enclosure to this letter provides the requested information including the method and date of closure of the identified findings listed in the inspection report. A small subset of Actions remains open (the enclosure provides further details), upon completion, a subsequent written notification will be provided to the NRC.

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
