I'd like to thank you and your staff for your time during the NRC inspection at your facility in Idaho Falls, Idaho. As we discussed at the end of the on-site inspection, there were no violations were identified. In addition, the two violations cited during the NRC inspection conducted on May 27, 2015, were closed. These violations were regarding (A) the failure to lock four gauges or their containers while in storage; and (B) the failure to provide DOT hazmat refresher training at least every three years to two employees who were transporting gauges. The attached NRC Inspection Report (NRC Form 591M) documents the results of the inspection. This does not require you to take any action and you are not required to sign it or return it.
