Dear Ms. Henderson:

Enclosed is a copy of the proposed revisions to Wisconsin Chapter DHS 157 'Radiation Protection'. The proposed rulemaking notice was published on Wisconsin's legislative website for a public comment period on December 19, 2016. We request NRC's comments by February 22, 2017. The enclosed revisions are identified by line in/line out text and correspond to the following equivalent amendments to NRC's regulations. The RATS-ID numbers listed below are the first of four rule packages being submitted to the NRC as part of this draft revision.

We believe that adoption of these revisions satisfies the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200.

1. With regard to RATS-ID 2009-1, the enclosed changes address NRC comments communicated via letter dated July 14, 2010. Note that we disagree with portions of several comments made in

the letter. We have included text from our existing rule to demonstrate that our rule text is compatible with the equivalent provision in 10 CFR 35.

2. With regard to RATS-ID 2011-1, Wisconsin does not allow termination of licenses under restricted conditions so changes to 10 CFR 20.1403 were not incorporated.
