In an April 8, 2016, letter, NuScale Power, LLC, submitted for U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff review Topical Report (TR) TR-0915-17565, "Accident Source Term Methodology," Revision 1. The NRC staff is performing a detailed review of this topical report to enable the staff to reach a conclusion on the safety of the proposed application. The NRC staff has identified that additional information is needed to continue portions of the review. The NRC staff's request for additional information (RAI), proprietary in nature, is contained in the enclosure to this letter.
