Letter to manufacturers

Dear Manufacturer of Smith & Wesson Watches,
CampCo recently worked with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to ensure that all our Tritium Watches follow the very strict guidelines set out by the Agreement State requirements. The following issues have been resolved, and we wanted to bring them to your attention so that we can avoid any potential issues in the future. CampCo has been absolved in the following 4 areas of potential violation:

- 1) Distributing watches containing tritium (hydrogen-3) without first either NRC approval by amendment to CampCo's existing license or by obtaining a separate NRC exempt distribution license for these watches;
- 2) Failing to submit timely required annual reports to the NRC;
- 3) Failing to provide required information in the annual reports provided upon NRC request; and
- 4) Failing to provide certificates with each lot of watches as required by the CampCo license.

We are happy to inform you that CampCo has been deemed in complete compliance with the NRC Agreement State requirements and we will continue working closely with the NRC to ensure the successful continuation of all Smith & Wesson Tritium Watches.
