Please clarify this discrepancy and please clarify if a name change or transfer of control or change of ownership in accordance with 10 CFR 30.34(b) has occurred.

4. Please note that although you list the storage location as an address in Cushing, Oklahoma, please note that the NRC does not have jurisdiction in the State of Oklahoma.

Therefore, we will "temporary job sites" as the use/storage location.

5. Please specify the manufacturer and model of the gauge that the portable gauge sealed sources will be used.
