By letter dated December 20, 2016 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession No. ML16364A091), SHINE Medical Technologies, Inc. (SHINE) submitted its Safeguards Information (SGI) Protection Program procedures for U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) review.

In the course of reviewing SHINE's SGI Protection Program procedures, the NRC staff has determined that additional information is required to complete its evaluation. This information is necessary to demonstrate SHINE's compliance with the regulations contained in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Parts 73, "Physical Protection of Plants and Materials" and 50, "Domestic Licensing of Production and Utilization Facilities."

Therefore, the NRC has prepared the attached draft request for additional information (RAI). This draft is provided to ensure that the request is clear and understandable.
