This is to acknowledge receipt of your application, dated December 21, 2016, for renewal of the materials license identified above. Your application is deemed timely filed, and accordingly, the license will not expire until final action has been taken by this office.

NRC staff has conducted a review of your application for renewal and found the sections are complete and acceptable for docketing. NRC staff will now begin its detailed review of your application to determine whether the proposed activities will be protective of public health and safety and demonstrate compliance with the regulations regarding the applicable sections in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), including 10 CFR Parts 20, "Standards for Protection against Radiation;" 40, "Domestic Licensing of Source Material;" and 51, "Environmental Protection Regulations for Domestic Licensing and Related Regulatory Functions." NRC staff expects the detailed review to be completed within approximately 180 days, not including any duration necessary for Water Remediation Technology, LLC to provide additional information requested by NRC staff to complete its detailed review.
