Subject: Follow-up to notification of loss of licensed material dated 1/5/17.

To Whom It May Concern,

Agilent Technologies, Inc. notified the NRC of the loss of two Electron Capture Detectors (ECDs) in a letter dated January 5th, 2017. Requested information under 10 CFR 20.2201 includes item vi, "Procedures or measures that have been, or will be, adopted to ensure against a recurrence of the loss or theft of licensed material." We answered that request as follows:

- Agilent has committed to, and is in final stages of, terminating services by Worldwide Flight Services at JFK and transferring inbound handling to a different company's warehouse at O'Hare International Airport in Chicago IL. Agilent will follow this written notice with confirmation of the change when it has been put into place.

I am following up that letter to notify your office that the proposed change has been enacted. We have changed warehousing from Worldwide Flight Services to FedEx Trade Networks out of O'Hare International Airport in Chicago Illinois.
