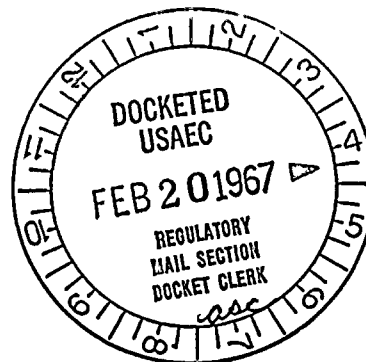
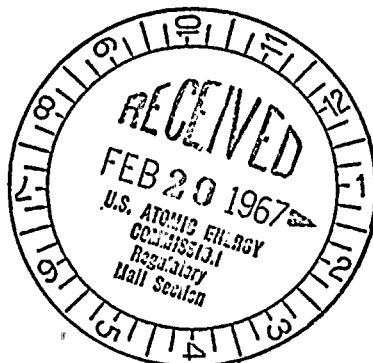
Attached is a table of the data requested in your letter of January 31, 1967. This information is based on our current fuel design. The data for withdrawals are firm but the data for returns are estimated.

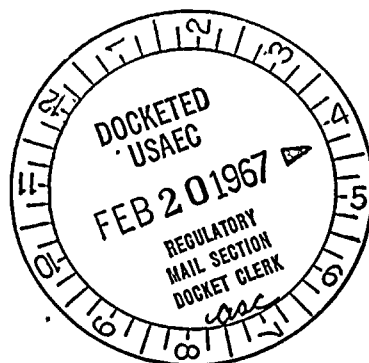
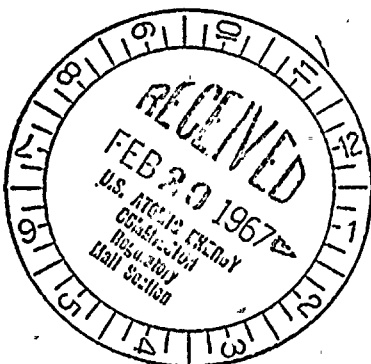
