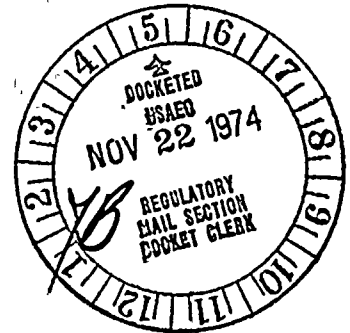

Proposed Changes to the Technical Specifications

Proposed changes to the Technical Specifications would increase the assurance of reliability of the Bergin Patterson snubbers in performing their intended function.

This change is being made as a result of directions to provide proposed changes to the Technical Specifications describing snubber surveillance in the Atomic Energy Commission's letter of October 1, 1973. Niagara Mohawk has implemented an inspection program as outlined in our letter.¹ Since that time no deterioration has been found. Therefore, adequate surveillance inspections can be performed at each major refueling outage. Reporting will be continued as previously described.^{2,3}

Proposed Change to the Technical Specifications

<u>Item</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Change</u>
Surveillance Requirement 4.1.3e	Pg. 30	Add 2nd paragraph to read as follows: "All Bergin Patterson snubbers will be visually inspected for overall integrity and for signs of leakage indicating seal degradation."
Bases for Specification 3.1.3 and 4.1.3	Pg. 31	Add a 4th paragraph to read as follows: "Indications of deterioration in Bergin Patterson snubbers at other reactor sites has established a need to assure the reliability of these snubbers. Inspection frequency has been based on operating performance of Bergin Patterson snubbers at Nine Mile Point Unit 1."
