


MATERIALS LICENSE

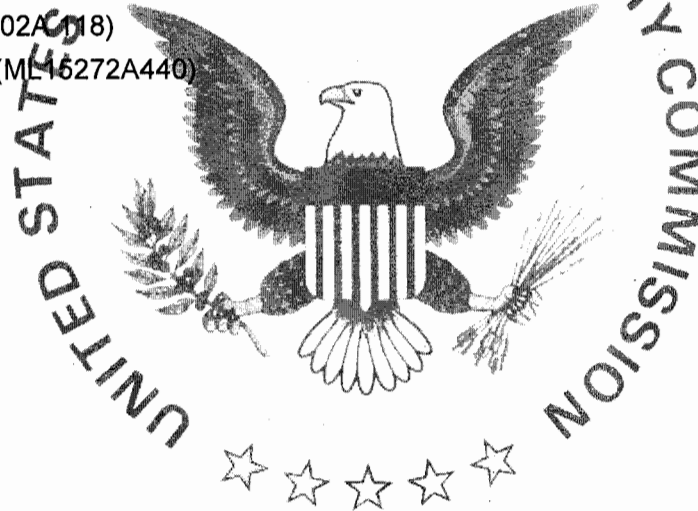
