Dear Dr. Basha:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 41 to your NRC Material License No. 21-20416-01 in accordance with your November 14, 2016 (ML16327A504) request to add a new stress/treadmill area of use to your license. Please note that – as discussed via phone with your medical physicist consultant Ray A. Carlson, M.S., on February 9, 2017, additional information is needed to remove the old stress/treadmill area of use from your license. Please also note that we have deleted Condition No. 13 in accordance with current NRC policy to include the reference to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Part 71, "Packaging and Transportation of Radioactive Material," in the preamble, on page 1 of the license.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we may provide appropriate corrections and answers.

To remove the old stress/treadmill area of use, please resubmit your request, including copies of closeout surveys, which you indicated in your letter are on file at your office. Closeout information should include last date on which material was used and/or stored in the old room, confirmation that all licensed material has been removed from that room, copies of final closeout surveys for the old room (including background readings), name of the individual performing those surveys, date on which final closeout surveys were performed, and survey instrument information including efficiency and most recent calibration dates. Your resubmitted request to remove the old area of use should be submitted under signed and dated letter. You may submit your request via regular mail, express carrier service, or via facsimile to (630) 515-1078.
