In an e-mail dated February 17, 2017, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), you requested to withdraw Technetics' pending export license application XCOM1268. In response to the e-mail, the NRC is returning the application to Technetics Group Columbia without action.

License application XCOM1268 requested the export of nine sets of reactor pressure vessel seal sets, clips and screws to China for use at the Qinshan Phase I Nuclear Power Plant.

As the NRC had already begun processing and reviewing the application, we cannot refund the \$9,600 licensing fee that Technetics Group Columbia submitted to the NRC on June 10, 2013.
