Dear Mr. Pettigrew:

I am writing to update you on the status of your export license application (PXB211.00), currently under review by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), for the export of gas and oil well logging sources to Iraq. As per Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* 110.40(d), if the Commission has not completed action on a license application within 60 days after receipt of Executive Branch judgement, the NRC is required to inform the applicant in writing of the reason for the delay.

The NRC received Executive Branch views on your license application in late December of 2016. The Commission paper required for the application's review has been signed by our Acting Director, and your application has been delivered to the Commission.
