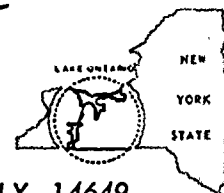

Dear Mr. Saltzman:

I am writing to supplement my letter to you of March 28, 1979, regarding the above claim and in accordance with 10 CFR 140.6.

With respect to the claim by Donald C. Gray, discussed in that letter, the plaintiff alleges that he suffered injuries as a result of overexposure to radiation while working as an independent contractor's employee in the Company's Ginna Nuclear Power Plant in January, 1974.

Additionally, on August 6, 1979, the Company was made aware of two similar potential actions for injuries, suffered from alleged exposure, on the same project and during the same period. The two potential claimants, Thomas E. Michaels and Albert H. Morrison, will also claim that they suffered personal injuries from overexposure to radiation while working for the same independent contractor which employed Mr. Gray.

The Company investigation to date reveals that the plaintiff and potential plaintiffs were employees of the Nuclear Installation Services Corporation at that time, and had been involved in the repair of the spent fuel storage facility at Ginna Station. The Company's records as obtained from the reports R. S. Landauer Jr. and Company show: that two of the claimants (including the plaintiff) were not exposed to radiation in excess of 3.0 rems per quarter during the time that they worked at the Ginna Station; and that the third claimant was exposed to 4.17 rems.
