This is an amendment request to change the above referenced radioactive materials license (RAML). The requests are enumerated below:

1. Please remove Catherine Anderko as the Radiation Safety Officer.
2. Please add Emily Chasteen, M.S. as the Radiation Safety Officer.
 - Ms. Chasteen is named as a Radiation Safety Officer on the attached copy of Arizona Radioactive Materials License 08-044 for the same type of use as the above referenced license. This license is current with in the past 7 years.
 - Please see the attached signed Delegation of Authority
3. Please remove the following AU's from Section 12.B of our RAML:
 - Surendra V Pawar, M.D.
 - John Anthony Leon, M.D.
 - Ravi Jain, M.D.
4. In order to more closely reflect this license operations, we request that the license be amended to allow temporary job sites only as described in Appendix V of NUREG 1556, that is "in-van use". The operations for InSight Health under this RAML are mobile PET/CT; operations are contained in the mobile vehicle. We do not have a permanent base location, rather the mobile vehicle is the base location. Our radioactive material (RAM) is delivered directly to the mobile coach and used only on our coaches, and not at the client sites currently listed on the license.

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For this reason, we are requesting that all client site locations be removed from condition 10-part A of our license. All of these clients were treated as temporary job sites where RAM was under InSight Health's control.

5. Due to changes in personnel and management structure, Anthony Sikorski will now be the signatory authority delegate as described in NUREG 1556 part 3- Management.

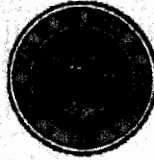

- C. The Alternate Safety Officers are: **Maxim Baldytchev, M.S.**, Kale D. Bodily, M.D., Wade G. Alleman, M.D., **Amirth Johnson, M.S.**
13. A licensee shall not receive radioactive material until all of the radiation safety proposals described in the license application have been met or are in place.
14. A. The licensee shall not change or modify a PET facility, or operations involving radioactive material, authorized under this license so that individuals exposed to radiation in or around the facility are exposed to radiation in excess of the levels in A.A.C. 12-1-408 and A.A.C. 12-1-416.
- B. The licensee shall be informed at all times of activities in areas surrounding the PET facility to ensure that personnel occupancy does not change, resulting in radiation exposure in excess of the levels in A.A.C. 12-1-408 and A.A.C. 12-1-416.
- C. As part of the annual ALARA review required under R12-1-407, the licensee shall review the PET patient workload to ensure that personnel in unrestricted areas are not exposed to radiation in excess of the limits in A.A.C. 12-1-408 and A.A.C. 12-1-416.
- D. The licensee shall not image more than 40 PET patients in a five day work week.
15. For purposes of ending the principal activities authorized under this radioactive material license:
- A. The license stays in effect beyond the license expiration date. Beyond the expiration date the licensee shall store radioactive material only, until the Agency authorizes its use by license amendment, or the Agency notifies the licensee in writing that the license is terminated.
- B. The licensee shall ensure the timeliness of decommissioning of facilities where principal activities are conducted under this license in accordance with Agency requirements.
- C. The licensee shall continue to control public access into restricted areas and pay the annual licensing fee until the license is terminated.
16. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use the radioactive material described in Items 6, 7 and 8 of this license in accordance with the statements, representations and procedures contained in:
1. Application received December 22, 2011, signed by Brian J. Turney.

The most recent statements, representations, and procedures shall govern if they conflict with previously submitted documents, unless otherwise specified by a license condition; and the Agency's rules shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters.



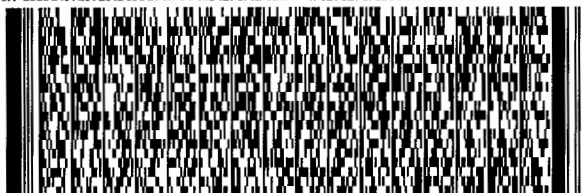

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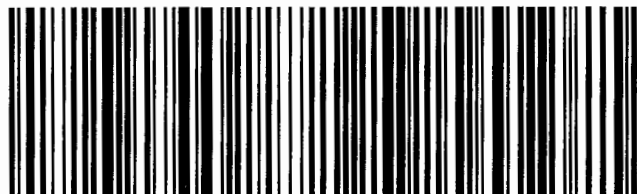
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
