This report (WCAP-14333-P) provides the Westinghouse Owners Group (WOG) technical documentation and methodology for relaxation of requirements for bypass times for testing, allowed outage times (AOT), and completion times for the Reactor Protection System (RPS) instrumentation and Engineered Safety Features Actuation System (ESFAS) instrumentation in WOG plants. The approach used is consistent with the previously approved Westinghouse Owners Group Technical Specification Optimization Program (WOG-TOPS). WCAP-14333-P is being submitted for NRC review and approval. The objective is that

once approved, each WOG member may reference this report in implementing these relaxations for their plant. The Westinghouse Owners Group lead plant for first implementation is Rochester Gas & Electric's Ginna plant, who is requesting approval for implementing this relaxation in conjunction with their conversion to the new standard Technical Specifications.
