SUMMARY OF MANAGEMENT ACTIONS

FFD PROGRAM

No significant program changes occurred in the six months ending December 31, 1997.

RG&E's annual testing rate is 50%.

REPORTABLE EVENT

One reportable event occurred during this period. On July 1, 1997, a licensed operator reported for a random drug and alcohol test. On July 7, 1997, the Medical Review Officer (MRO) declared the test confirmed positive for marijuana. Unescorted site access was immediately revoked. The employee received the required discipline and reported to the Employee Assistance Program (EAP) for evaluation and treatment. The employee has successfully completed the EAP recommendations, received a Return to Work Clearance through the MRO, and scheduled for three years of follow-up testing. The employee's unescorted site access was reinstated on October 28, 1997, however, the employee is no longer a licensed operator.
