
Dear Mr. Griev:

From March 15, 1974 to date, CallData Systems, Inc. has had a license, granted by Arthur D. Little, Inc., to offer the ADLPIPE computer code on the CallData computer system. During that period, Burns & Roe, Inc., a CallData client, used the ADLPIPE code for Pipe Design on the referenced project.

Therefore, in accordance with NRC I.E. bulletin number 79-07, Burns & Roe, Inc. has requested that we supply your office with a copy of the portion of the ADLPIPE code which uses the algebraic intra-modal summation technique. As an A.D. Little licensee, we are authorized to access the code for maintenance purposes only; therefore, in transmitting it to the NRC we must request that the code be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (b) (1) of 10 CFR, Section 2.790, of the NRC regulations.

Thus, we are sending copies of the code, for each release of ADLPIPE, which falls under the conditions of IE 79-07 along with an affidavit requesting confidentiality for all of the code supplied.
