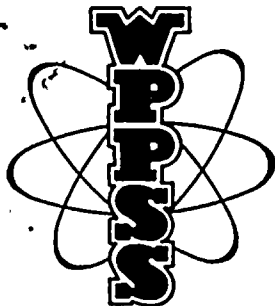

Subject: WPPSS Nuclear Project No. 2
Request for Meeting -
RSB/ICSB/Savannah River

As you are aware, Savannah River Labs is conducting the base review on WNP-2 in the areas of concern for Instrumentation and Controls Systems Branch (ICSB) and Reactor Systems Branch (RSB). It is our understanding that this review has been completed and that draft questions have been prepared and submitted through RSB and ICSB to the NRC WNP-2 Project Manager. Since the Savannah River contract with the NRC effectively terminates at the end of September, we feel it is important to have a meeting with ICSB, RSB, and Savannah River before the contract expires to discuss informally their concerns. It would also be helpful to have at least a draft copy of the ICSB/RSB questions before the meeting. Accordingly, we request the following:

- 1) A meeting with RSB/ICSB branches and appropriate personnel from Savannah River to discuss their concerns on the WNP-2 docket.
- 2) A copy of the RSB/ICSB questions from Savannah River (a draft copy is satisfactory) in advance of the meeting.

For planning purposes, we propose September 18 for the date of the meeting at your offices. We would expect the meeting to last all day. We note that similar meetings have been held on the Susquehannah docket.

Informal exchanges with representatives from Savannah River have indicated that they would be willing to follow-up on their review of the WNP-2 docket after the September 30th contract expiration date. It is our impression that follow-up implies review of WPPSS responses to their concerns and subsequent changes to the draft SER input. It is apparent that this continuity would be beneficial, so we would like to discuss this at the meeting also.
