In Reference 1, you requested that the Supply System incorporate comments from the Yakima Indian Nation in the Emergency Preparedness Plan for WNP-2. Our letter of October 6, 1982 (Reference 2), stated that we were planning to meet with representatives of the Yakima Indian Nation, the State of Washington and FEMA on October 22, 1982, to discuss off-site emergency planning.

The meeting planned for October 22 did not occur due to the fact that representatives of the Yakima Indian Nation were either unable or unwilling to meet at that time. At this point in time, we have no plans for a future meeting with the Yakima Indian Nation. A meeting can only result from mutual agreement by both parties. To date, we have received no indication of willingness on the part of the Yakima Indian Nation to



Subject: PROPOSED MEETING ON EMERGENCY PLANNING

My letter of September 30, 1982, requested a meeting with you or your representative on October 22, 1982, to discuss emergency planning being done for our nuclear projects on the Hanford Reservation. Representatives of the State of Washington Department of Emergency Services and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) would also participate in that meeting.

As I have been unable to confirm with you your availability or willingness to meet as requested, I have canceled our plans for the October 22 meeting. Notice of cancellation was communicated to your office by telephone on October 20, 1982.

In our telephone conversation of October 7, I noted that we would be meeting in the near future with representatives of all of the counties within 50 miles of the plant site to discuss emergency planning. We would like to include the Yakima Nation in these meetings, but obviously need your cooperation to do so. Please advise me as to an acceptable date and time when we can meet.
