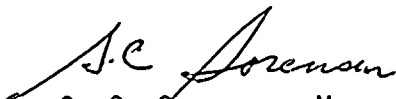

OPERATING LICENSE NPF-21  
RESPONSE TO NRC BULLETIN 88-08, THERMAL  
STRESSES IN PIPING CONNECTED TO  
REACTOR COOLANT SYSTEMS

The subject bulletin requested licensees to 1) review their reactor coolant systems (RCSs) to identify any connected, unisolable piping that could be subject to temperature distributions which would result in unacceptable thermal stresses and 2) take action, where such piping is identified, to ensure that the piping will not be subjected to unacceptable thermal stresses.

Accordingly, the Supply System has completed the review of all systems interacting with or connected to the reactor coolant system and confirmed that none of the systems are susceptible to conditions of thermal cycling or temperature stratification that could be induced by leaking valves. As instructed by the subject bulletin no additional actions are necessary.
