On May 19, 1989, the Science Applications International Company informed the Supply System of an analytical error on sample analysis used to develop scaling factors for Dry Active Waste. It is our understanding that Mr. Roy Person (USNRC) is aware of the deficiency.

The first and second Semi-Annual Radioactive Effluent Reports for calendar year 1988 have now been reviewed and revised to reflect the changes in scaling factor data and resulting under reporting of radionuclide activities. The under reported nuclide activities results in less than a .1% change in the overall reported activities. A revised Section 4 for References 2) and 3) is enclosed.
