
The purpose of this letter is to confirm that the following information was provided to the Senior NRC Resident Inspector on Thursday, November 9, 1989:

- 1) All remedial actions, that would have been required by the LCO's in the deleted Technical Specification are currently in place.
- 2) An interim change to plant procedure 1.3.10 to specifically incorporate all the fire protection surveillances, remedial actions, and LCOs which were removed from the Tech Specs by Amendment 67 to the WNP-2 operating license has been completed. All future changes to this procedure will be conducted in accordance with 10 CFR 50.59.

- 3) Permanent plant procedures implementing the fire protection program, remedial actions and operational conditions, as discussed in 2 above, will be in place by November 29, 1989.
- 4) By November 22, 1989, the Supply System will submit an amendment to the FSAR which discusses the fire protection surveillances, remedial actions and LCOs discussed in 2.
