INSERVICE INSPECTION AND TESTING INTERVAL EXTENSION**

Reference: Letter GO2-94-186, dated August 8, 1994, JV Parrish (SS) to NRC,  
"Request for Amendment to Technical Specification 4.0.5, Surveillance  
Requirements for Inservice Inspection and Testing Program"

This letter is to inform the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of the Supply System's intent to extend the first Ten-Year Inservice Inspection and Test Interval(s) for no longer than six months (December 13, 1994, to not later than June 12, 1995). This is done as provided for in Section XI, subarticle IWA-2400(c) of the ASME Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code, 1980 Edition through Winter 1980 Addenda. This section states that "Each inspection interval may be decreased or extended (but not cumulatively) by as much as 1 year."

The intervals are extended so that implementation of the ISI/IST programs for the second Ten-Year interval will commence after approval of the technical specification change requested by the reference. The Supply System will implement ISI/IST programs for the new Ten-Year interval in a timely manner upon receipt of the approved technical specification change and notify the NRC of the actual date of implementation. Upon implementation of the new programs, to preserve the cumulative one year extension allowance provided by IWA-2400(c) discussed above, the second Ten-Year intervals will be identified as ending December 12, 2004.

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
